**GARBAGE**



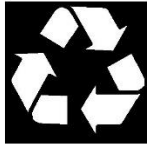
**COST IS STILL \$2 PER BAG  
PAYABLE IN THE HONOR BOX**

- No Appliances • No Yard Waste
- No Un-Bagged Garbage
- No Hazardous Materials such as liquid paint, oil, household or car batteries

Large items are only accepted at the Spring & Fall Cleanups  
(There is a container available for used motor oil)

**RECYCLE**

- Glass: Food & drink containers, rinse clean & remove lids
- Plastic Containers: **MUST** have recycling symbol 1-7. Rinse clean & remove lids.
- Tin Cans ~ Rinse clean.
- Empty aerosol cans are recyclable
- Aluminum Cans and Foil ~ Please rinse; foil must be aluminum
- Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, and Cardboard ~ Flatten and place in separate dumpster next to recycle bin



**NOT RECYCLABLE:**

- No plastic bags or Styrofoam
- No concrete or liquid paint
- No mirrors, ceramic cups/plates, clay flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, window glass, drinking glasses, heat resistant ovenware

To clarify garbage collection policies: The town provides two trash dumpsters – a large co-mingle bin, and one for paper/cardboard dumpster at the Town Hall. During the year, only BAGGED garbage may be deposited in the dumpsters under the shelter (provide your own bags).

There is an "Honor Box" for you to deposit your payment of \$2 per bag of garbage. Last year, the town's expenses exceeded our collections by over \$5,400. We appreciate your continued efforts in this area to help keep your taxes down.

A large co-mingle recycling bin is provided at no charge and includes: Glass, tin, aluminum, and plastic. Please help keep these areas neat and accessible.

**OTHER OPTIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF THE FOLLOWING**

E-Waste: Goodwill of Richland Center accepts the following items year-round at no charge: Laptops, Notebooks, Tablets, DVD Players, VCRs, DVRs, Fax Machines, Flat Monitors (not TVs), Printers, All-in-Ones, other small appliances (excluding Microwaves), Desktop Computers, and any other computer accessories.

Tires: L&M takes tires year-round and many other items. 608-647-3490

Bulbs, ballasts, batteries, flags: Walsh's Ace Hardware takes these items. Check for current prices. 608-647-8925

Plastic bags and computer ink cartridges: Walmart will take these items. Call ahead to verify any changes with any of the above.

Do not leave appliances, furniture, or other large or unbagged items during the year. The fine is \$300.

**The town has cameras and turns in the photos of violators to the sheriff's department.**

Restitution has been made by violators who have been apprehended & fined.
