

**RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2022 BUDGET NO. 2022-02
TOWN OF FOREST, RICHLAND COUNTY**

A resolution changing the 2022 budget of the Town of Forest, Richland County, Wisconsin, adopted by a two-thirds majority vote of the entire membership of the Town of Forest board under Wis. Stat. § 65.90(5).

Whereas, year-to-date, the Fund Balance (after all bills are paid for 2022) has a balance of \$62,327 in balance from quicken of Money Market and Now account total;

Whereas, year-to-date, the Highway Maintenance Expense Account has a deficit of \$47,552.69;

THEREFORE, the town board of the Town of Forest, Richland County, does hereby resolve and order as follows:


That the sum of \$54,902 is hereby transferred from Sale of Highway Equipment (\$12,000), Insurance Recovery (\$19,000), County Highway & Bridge Aid (\$6,108) and Federal and State Grants (\$17,794) to Highway Maintenance; and the sum of \$7,350 from Highway Maintenance to FEMA Highway Reimbursement. Also, the amount of \$17,441 from Fund Balance to FEMA Highway Reimbursement.
